GEOPHYSICAL SURVEYS UNDERWAY - John S. Brock, president of  
TO DEFINE DRILL TARGETS Triumph Resources Ltd. has  
reported seven holes have  
now been completed over a 200 meter strike length on the  
Mt. Alcock zinc-lead property 240 km NW of MacKenzie, B.C.  
The AK89-3 hole intercept of the zinc lead barite horizon  
was at 130 meters down-dip from the surface exposure.

An expanded exploration program is now under way.  
Induced polarization (IP) surveys will start in a few  
days to aid in targetting massive sulphide zones within  
the 2.5 km zinc-lead anomaly. The 1989 drill program will  
then include step-out drilling from the presently defined
