NEW GOLD DISCOVERY - Bond International Gold Inc. reports a new gold discovery on its Red Mountain property 15 km. east of Stewart in NW B.C. The best diamond drill intersection to date from 13 holes is from the Marc-08 hole which intersected 66 meters averaging 9.88 grams gold/metric tonne plus 49.29 grams silver/t. The discovery consists of two steeply-dipping zones, the Marc zone and Brad zone, which intersect each other on surface at an angle of about 45 degrees. The Marc zone, which has been traced on surface over a strike length of 500 meters, was discovered by sampling trenches and reconnaissance drilling. Follow-up drilling at 50-meter intervals along strike continues to intersect broad mineralized zones. Assays for holes Marc-11 to 16 are pending.

The Brad zone, discovered by sampling of a surface outcrop that contained visible gold, has been traced for 350 meters on strike. A one-meter square panel sample from the outcrop returned 204 grams gold/t and a channel sample from another outcrop 60 meters south on strike returned 19.1 grams gold/t over a width of 3.5 meters. Assays from holes Brad 01 to 03 are pending.

Elsewhere on the claim group, 10 holes have been drilled into the Willoughby Gossan, 6 km. east of Red Mountain. All the holes intersected gold mineralization with the best hole, 89-06, intersecting 20.5 meters averaging 24.98 grams gold/t plus 184.21 grams silver/t.

Other areas of gold mineralization have been identified on the property. Bond has staked or entered into options for about 3,600 claim units covering some 225,000 acres. A portion of them cross the Stewart-Smithers highway, along which a power line has recently been constructed.

Bond International Gold is a major international gold producing company with mining interests in North

and South America and Australia.
