PRELIMINARY ASSAYS - Robin T. Forshaw, president, reports FROM ISKUT CLAIMS Kestrel Resources Ltd. has received preliminary assays from trench samples on the DeBock zone of its 100%-owned KRL claim group in the Iskut River area of NW B.C., 20 km. NW of the Calpine/Stikine 21 Zone. Eleven veins have been identified, and to date, six mineralized veins have been trenched. Four veins contained visible gold. The assay results below are from only part of one of the trenches, where the vein has been traced for more than 200 meters and varies from 40 cm. to one meter, 15 inches to 39 inches, in width. Visible gold has been noted for 26 meters. Additional results are pending.

Kestrel and THIOS RESOURCES LTD. (THI-V) are currently concluding a joint venture agreement and a decision on drilling the property this year is anticipated in the near future. Kestrel recently received proceeds of \$770,000 from its initial distribution of 1,400,000 shares at 55¢ each.
