STAR DRILL RESULTS - Gerald R. Newcomen, president,
reports Barkhor Resources Inc. and
Kokanee Explorations Ltd. have completed Phase I of the
diamond drilling program on the Star property located 35

miles south of Kimberley, B.C. Barkhor is earning a 50% interest by funding the initial \$600,000 of exploration. An independent engineering report by S.B. Hamilton recommends further drilling and exploration continue.

Barkhor notified operator Kokanee it wished to proceed to Phase II which provides for spending \$350,000 on exploration. Phase II is now underway with eight holes completed,, six on the initial area of interest and two wide step-out holes to the north. All holes intersected significant alteration and/or base and precious metal mineralization associated with known mineral deposits. As well, the holes in the immediate area of S90-2 have confirmed the stratiform nature of the mineralization reported previously. Assays are pending on holes S90-4, 6, 7 and 8.

S90-3, located 650 ft. SE of S90-2 and drilled at -45° and parallel to it, intersected veins and disseminated mineralization from 800 - 1,300 feet; SEE TABLE ABOVE. Hole S90-5 was drilled 1.5 km to the north to test an area of tourmaline alteration. It intersected zones of anomalous gold and some base metal values, also shown in table above. Drilling is continuing. (SEE GCNL No.133, 11Ju190, P.1 FOR PREVIOUS RESULTS)
