square mile Elk property. SEE TABLE ABOVE & MAP OVERLEAF. Surface sampling is complete over the exposed portion of the vein system and the present diamond drilling is 70% complete. Forty-one holes have been drilled on a wide-spaced 150-foot grid with 36 intersecting the structure. Hole 90-29 intersected at 400 feet down-dip substantially increasing the potential contained ounces of gold. Hole 90-33, with assays pending, intersected the structure at 500 feet down-dip.

finned four areas of significant areas of gold mineralization. SEE TABLE ABOVE. Areas 1-3 are contiguous and average 0.507 oz.gold/ton over a strike length of 1,280 feet diluted to 6.6 true width. The Siwash North gold deposit remains open to extension along strike and at depth.

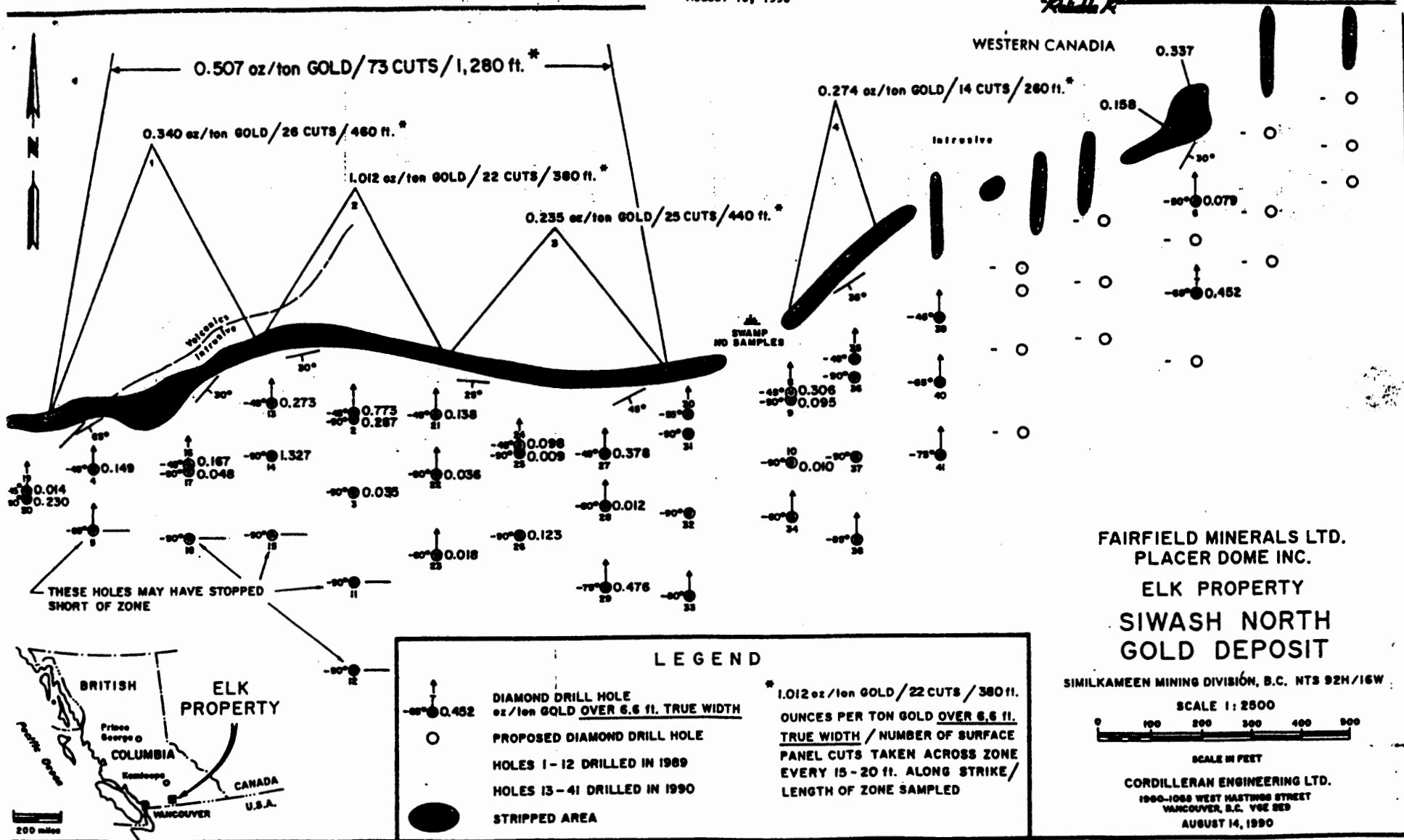
A new discovery, with assays pending, has been uncovered 3,000 feet south of Siwash North. This new vein system is well exposed at two locations over a 500-foot strike length and is still open. Several other gold showings and geochemical targets remain to be explored on the Elk property. Fairfield owns eight road-accessible gold properties covering 160 square miles, four of which are under option to Placer Dome. (SEE GCNL No.75, 18Apr90, P.1 FOR PROJECT REVIEW)

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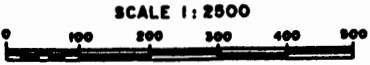
