300 FEET OF NATIVE COPPER - Glen E. White, president,
reports Liberty Gold Corp.

has intersected 300 feet of visible native copper in diamond drill hole No.6 on its 100%-owned Tim gold/copper porphyry project located near Lac La Hache about 70 km east of Williams Lake in central B.C. The Mt. Polley copper/gold deposit of Imperial Metals Corp. is 35 miles to the north and contains reserves of 53,700,000 tons grading 0.38% copper and 0.016 oz.gold/ton.

Hole No.6 was drilled westward at -45 degrees in the native copper zone to test a 150-foot exposure of native copper and malachite stain in altered volcanic rocks. The mineralization occurs in fractures and disseminations throughout a feldspathic andesite tuff. Some sections contain readily visible native copper that could host significant copper values.

Hole No.9 has confirmed the discovery and is being drilled eastward 80 meters from hole No.6. This anomaly is situated on the southern flank of a major induced polarization chargeability response over one mile in length. To date, eight diamond drill holes and seven percussion holes have been completed. An extensive well mineralized, highly propylitized (hydrothermally altered) volcanic breccia has been located. The core and chips are being logged and shipped for assay. Two diamond drills are currently operating. (SEE GCNL No.72, 11Apr90, P.3 FOR PREVIOUS INFORMATION.)
