INITIAL RESULTS IN - Lawrence J. Nagy, president,
Solomon Resources Ltd. reports
preliminary exploration on the Snippaker Mountain
project, 100 km northwest of Stewart, B.C., has
identified numerous precious-base metal targets. The
claims are immediately adjacent to the east of the
Cominco/Prime SNIP mine. Solomon can earn a 50%
interest by paying WINSLOW GOLD CORP. (WGC-V) \$80,000
and spending \$1,800,000 on exploration by 31Dec92.

On the south slopes of Snippaker Mountain and
adjacent to Bronson Creek, follow-up work on extensive
gold-in-soil geochemical anomalies has identified a 400
by 400-meter area of highly sheared, gossanous greywacke
that returned the following assays:

The mineralization is
' a new discovery and ap-
' pears to be, structurally
' related with sphalerite,
' galena, pyrite, pyrrho-
' tite and arsenopyrite
' occurring in pods, frac-
' ture fillings and dis-
' seminations within

highly gossanous sediments. Prospecting, mapping and
trenching of this new zone has been given top priority
and current fieldwork will determine the surface extent
and continuity of the mineralization before diamond
