EXPLORATION RESULTS - Ralph Brown, president, Rockridge
Mining Corp., reports results from
the 1990 exploration program on the Palmiere Creek
project located six miles northwest of the 21 zone
deposits at Eskay Creek, about 50 miles northwest of
Stewart. B.C. MEADFIELD MINING CORP., a private
company, can earn a 50% interest by paying \$25,000 and
spending \$250,000 on exploration over three years.

The 1990 Phase I program comprised prospecting, reconnaisance and detailed mapping, geochemical sampling and trenching. Mapping identified Mt. Dilworth and Salmon Arm stratigraphy along the length of the property. These are the same rock types hosting the 21 Zone deposits at Eskay Creek.

Several anomalous gold results ranging up to 100 parts per billion have been returned from rock samples collected in the A Creek zone, which is hosted by Mt. Dilworth and Betty Creek formation siltstones and volcaniclastics. The A Creek zone is a siliceous breccia zone at least 3.0 meters wide which carries quartz, pyrite, galena, chalcopyrite and realgar. Trenching in the vicinity of the A Creek zone exposed Mt. Dilworth volcanics carrying up to 20% heavy sulphide mineralization. Trench assay results are pending. Meadfield will making a public offering to raise funds for continued exploration.
