GOLDEN ARROW RESOURCES INC. (GAW-V)

PRELIMINARY RESULTS - James Anderson, director, reports Golden Arrow Resources Inc. has received assays from surface prospecting on the RB 1-2 property located in the Galore Creek area about 150 miles northwest of Stewart, B.C.

An intrusive contact, traceable for a strike length of over one km, has been identified running parallel to the Scud River. Mineralization comprises mainly of massive to disseminated pyrite and arsenopyrite in meter-long blebs found along the intrusive contact. The

first sample below represents a chip sample over a 1-meter width at the contact.
