MORE VISUAL RESULTS - Bellex Mining Corp. 50% and Quattro Resources Ltd. 50% have reported initial visual results from drill holes 2 and 3 on the J.W. property in the Galore Creek joint venture, NW B.C.

Drill hole #2 is located 100 meters south of drill hole #1. The following visual observations have been made: The top portion of the hole from 11.5 meters to 64.5 meters (174 ft.) contains 1 to 5% combined chalcopryite and pyrite within a chlorite epidote altered diorite and subvolcanics.

64.5 meters to 96 meters contains K-feldspar altered

silicified diorite with up to 1% chalcopryite. Several quartz veins and stringers with chalcopryite, pyrite and gelena mineralization (up to 10%) occur up to 0.5 meters in widths.

From 96 meters to 206 meters (end of hole) contains K-feldspar altered silicified diorite with patches of pyrite and chalcopryite mineralization.

Drill hole #3 is located 50 meters due north of drill hole #1:

From 3 meters to 50 meters contains an estimated 3.5% combined chalcopryite, pyrite mineralization within a highly chlorite-epidote altered sheared diorite. We continue to be within a strong porphyry system and expect to intersect the targeted quartz breccia (intersected in drill hole #1) within the next few days.

All drill holes are being drilled at a 45 angle and at an azimuth of 080 to 090.
