**GIGI RESOURCES LTD. (GIG-V)**

UPPER UNUK PROJECT UNDERWAY/ - John Ivany, president,  
TROPHY GOLD DRILLING STARTS reports Gigi Resources  
Ltd. has mobilized a  
field crew to the Upper Unuk project 55 miles northwest  
of Stewart, B.C. Gigi has an option to earn a 50%  
interest from TRADEWINDS RESOURCES LTD. (TDN-V).

The Upper Unuk River project consists of the KAN  
1-6 claims, centred three miles northeast of the 21 zone  
deposits at Eskay Creek. The KAN 1-4 and KAN 5 and 6  
claims are subject to two separate complaints filed  
under Section 35 of the Mineral Tenure Act of B.C.

There is no record of work having been carried out  
on the property. Mapping by B.C. Government geologists  
indicate much of the property is underlain by  
sedimentary units of the Salmon River and Ashman  
formations. The Mt. Dilworth formation, which hosts the  
21 zone deposits at Eskay Creek, is interpreted to cross  
the southeastern portion of the Upper Unuk River project.

The \$100,000 work program includes prospecting,  
reconnaissance mapping and geochemical sampling with  
grids to be made on favourable areas of the property.

Gigi has begun drilling on the Trophy gold project  
located in the Galore Creek area about 100 miles  
northwest of Stewart, B.C. Gigi can earn a 55% interest  
from CONTINENTAL GOLD CORP. (CNT-V; CNTVF-Nasdaq) by  
issuing 200,000 shares and spending \$5,500,000 on  
exploration over five years.

The initial drill program comprises a minimum five  
holes totalling 2,950 feet on the Ptarmigan zone where  
exploration in 1988 by Continental returned 0.156  
oz.gold/ton over 185 feet from surface sampling.  
Drilling of the zone in 1988 returned 0.16 oz.gold/ton  
and 0.88 oz.silver/ton over 36.4 feet. Some 700 feet of  
strike length will be tested. Elsewhere on the  
property, exploration continues to evaluate a number of  
the 21 mineral occurrences identified in previous field  
programs. A grid has been established on the southwest  
corner of the property in an area of gold and copper  
geochemical anomalies. A second drill program is planned  
for both the Ptarmigan zone and other promising targets.  
The 1990 exploration budget is \$1,000,000. (SEE GCNL
