**ANTELOPE RESOURCES LIMITED(ATF-V)**

HIGH GRADE GOLD INTERSECTION - Dal Bryneisen, president,  
Antelope Resources Inc.,  
and 50/50 joint venture partner BRYNDEN VENTURES INC.  
(BNV-T, Alberta) reports drilling on the Bluebird claim  
on the Rossland property in south-central B.C. has  
intersected 12.5 feet grading 0.33 oz.gold/ton in hole  
SB-90-3, indicating gold grades are increasing at depth  
on the Bluebird claim, which historically was a  
silver/lead/zinc producer. The hole was collared at  
-65° dip and intersected this zone at a vertical depth  
of 800 feet.

Holes SB-90-2 and SB-90-3 were collared 700 feet  
apart and were designed to test the main  
Bluebird/Mayflower zone at depth. Both of these  
exploratory holes indicated near surface  
silver/lead/zinc mineralization gives way at depth to  
increased gold values along the Bluebird/Mayflower zone.

Assays are pending for the remaining four holes of  
the Rossland, South Belt drill program. The drilling in  
the North Belt is scheduled to begin in late December or  
early Jan/91.

During its lifetime, the nearby Le Roi mine  
produced over 3,000,000 ounces of gold and 3,000,000  
ounces of silver from massive sulphide ore grading 0.52  
oz.gold/ton and 1% copper. (SEE GCNL No.219, 13Nov90,
