NAVARRÉ RESOURCES CORP. (NRV-V)

1990 FIELD WORK COMPLETED - Daniel Davis, president,
reports Navarre Resources

Corp. has completed a comprehensive program of geological mapping, geochemistry, geophysics, trenching and limited diamond drilling on six claim groups located 6 - 60 km north and south of Stewart, B.C. comprising 359 units covering 8,975 hectares. On the 100% owned Strike claims, located 20 km north of Stewart, mapping traced 18 quartz veins up to 7.0 feet wide over a strike length of one mile. 102 trench channel samples averaged 0.1% copper, 7% lead, 2% zinc, 1.30 oz.silver/ton and 0.043 oz.gold/ton across an average width of 2.5 feet. A grab sample from one vein assayed 0.06% copper, 10.08% lead, 0.33% zinc, 429.82 oz.silver/ton and 2.304 oz.gold/ton. Pulse EM geophysics outlined a well defined 3,200 foot long conductor in the north portion of the mineralized zone. Diamond drilling intersected 0.15 oz.gold/ton over 3.8 feet. The drilling did not test the geophysical conductor to the north; 10,000 feet of drilling is planned for 1991.

On the 100% owned Ice claims, located 10 km north of Stewart and 2 km east of the Silbak-Premier mine, one hole was drilled to 324 feet and halted short of the projected depth. The bottom of the hole returned 0.03% copper, 0.37% lead, 9.24% zinc, 10.02 oz.silver/ton and 0.052 oz.gold/ton across 0.6 feet. Further drilling is planned for next season. At the Trump, VG, Three Mile and Golden Crest claims, located 6 - 60 km east and south of Stewart, reconnaissance mapping and sampling identified mineral showings of copper, lead, zinc, silver and gold.
