> PUP PROJECT SUMMARY - Murray Pezim, chairman, Consolidated Goldwest Resources Ltd., provides a summary of exploration work on the Pup project located in the Galore Creek mining camp some 150 miles northwest of Stewart, B.C. Goldwest is in the second year of a four-year option to earn a 100% interest in the Pup project. The property is comprised of seven claims totalling 101 units covering 6,200 acres, centered about eight km. north of the Central zone of the Galore Creek porphyry copper deposit which hosts 125,000,000 tons grading 1.06% copper. Exploration in 1989 by Goldwest discovered two areas of

interest, the Saddle and Malachitre zones, the focus of

the 1990 work. This season's program included grid establishment, mapping, soil sampling, VLF-EM and magnetometer surveys, primarily on the Saddle zone, which features several parallel, northerly-trending shear zones covering an area some 300 meters wide by 1,700 meters long. Associated with the shears are irregular sulphide-bearing quartz veins. Grab samples from the Saddle zone returned assays as high as 1.92% copper and 1.91% zinc., and 0.038 Oz.gold/ton, 1.95% lead and 3.4% zinc. The 1990 soil sampling showed a strong gold and copper anomaly up to 200 meters wide, coincident with the Saddle zone; soil assays were up to 0.041 oz.gold/ton. The VLF-EM survey showed a north-trending conductor over the known length of the Saddle zone, offset about 50 meters to the east of the geochemical anomaly.

Nork on the Malachite zone comprised mapping, prospecting and contour soil geochemical sampling. The best grab sample result was 0.036 oz.gold/ton and 2.05% copper. A third area of interest, the Pickston zone, was discovered in 1990. Eleven grab samples from a gossanous shear zone, which comprises the zone, returned anomalous copper assays in the 150-5300 parts per million range.

Consolidated Goldwest has also recently completed its 1990 exploration program on the Teryl Option project with <u>TYMAR RESOURCES INC.</u> (TMZ-V,T), located in the Iskut River area, 100 miles NW of Stewart, B.C. and four miles northwest of the Prime/Cominco SNIP deposit.
