HOPE OF DISCOVERY PROJECT UNDERWAY - Boris Klarich,
secretary, reports
Forbes Resources Ltd. has recently begun work on its

gold/silver/lead/zinc/copper property, the Hope of Discovery, located in the southern Kootenay Lake area about 40 km north of Creston, B.C. The company can earn a 100% interest by paying \$62,000 and issuing 50,000 shares. To find the sources of known geophysical and geochemical anomalies, this phase of work will include the establishment of a grid, geological mapping, soil geochemical surveys, trenching and sampling. Old records show shipments of ore containing 3.45 oz.silver/ton and 0.356 oz.gold/ton. Results of the first phase of exploration confirmed recorded assays ranging from 0.004 to 0.014 oz.gold/ton, 2.26 to 35.38 oz.silver/ton, 2.04 to 71.20% lead and 1.83 to 28.81% zinc. The first-phase report also concludes there is a possibility of skarn-type mineralization as evidenced by high temperature minerals such as tungsten. Forbes has started negotiations on several mineral properties in the Galore, Iskut River, Eskay Creek and Mt. Milligan areas of B.C.
