<u>The Legion property</u> covers an area of Proterozoic volcanics and carbonate/clastic sediments hosting a stratiform zinc zone. Previous induced polarization surveys and geochemical soil surveys have traced the zinc mineralization for at least five km along strike.

In the early 1960s, 13 short diamond drill holes confirmed the presence of stratiform zinc mineralization over a strike length of 400 meters. This drilling included 1.5 meters grading 14.9% zinc and 9.0 meters grading 5-6% zinc. A drill-indicated tonnage estimate of 500,000 tons grading 5% zinc was made in 1966.

<u>The zinc zone, Wilds Creek</u>, is interpreted to be of a volcanogenic sedimentary exhalative nature which is open to the north and south along strike and at depth.
