ALTERED SEDIMENTS CUT - White Knight Resources has been advised by operator KALI VENTURE CORP. (KIV-V) that drilling continues on the Sullivan Two property 10 km west of Creston, B.C. Kali can earn 50% by paying \$200,000, issuing 150,000 shares and spending \$800,000 on exploration over three years.

Hole 90-S-05 intersected 95 ft., from 50 to 145 feet, of altered Aldridge formation sediments containing disseminated and bedding parallel lead and zinc sulphides. Hole 90-S-02, drilled about 500 meters south of 90-S-05, intersected about 10 feet of oxidized and altered Aldridge sediments with visible sulphide mineralization at a depth of 165 feet.

Holes 90-S-01 and 90-S-03 were lost in overburden and a shallow fault zone. Hole 90-S-04, located about 700 meters southeast of 90-S-05, intersected altered sediments throughout the length of the hole, which was stopped at 690 feet before the target stratigraphy was reached. The work indicates grade and thickness increases to the east towards the centre of the claims.
