started exploration work on

the Sun property, 3 km southwest of the Barkhor Resources/ Kokanee Star property, 40 km. south of the Sullivan Mine, SE B.C. (See location map overleaf P.3 GCNL No.121, 22June90).

A strong lead zinc geochemical soil anomaly, 1900 metres long and up to 600 metres wide was identified on the Sun property by th previous operator - Cominco, Ltd. This anomaly has never been tested by drilling.

The main showing area on the Sun property contains two old adits which host geological indicators of Sullivan type massive lead-zinc-silver mineralization including sedimentary breccias and quartz-sulfide veins.

A grab sample from one of seven veins outcropping on the Sun property recently returned assay values of 56.56% lead and 18.65 oz./ton silver.

The current program will include geological and geophysical work prior to diamond drilling.
