BRIGHTWORK RESOURCES INC. (BWI-V)

EXPLORATION BEGINS - Timothy L. Williams, president, reports Brightwork Resources Inc. has begun its 1990 exploration program at Orofino Mountain located 15 km south of Penticton, B.C. The program, to be conducted by Orequest Consultants, will comprise trenching to determine the source of a recently discovered float sample which assayed 2.70 oz.gold/ton. The lower Independence adit will be opened and further examination of underground workings will be carried out prior to the start of a diamond drill program. The minimum 2,000 foot drill program is designed to test the Independence veins in a number of locations along strike and at depth. A detailed sampling program of a dump on the property will follow up recent sampling which returned 0.18 oz.gold/ton. The dump sampling has the objective of determining grade, tonnage and metallurgy.

The Brightwork property is an historical high grade gold producer with limited production from numerous workings on the property. Reports indicate production from the Independence adit was 10,547 tons yielding 5,639 ounces of gold. Total production from the Orofino camp was 24,058 tons recovering 8,858 ounces of gold. The company has acquired a 100% interest, subject to a 2% net smelter return royalty, in two claim blocks adjoining the eastern boundary of the Orofino property by paying \$10,000 and issuing 100,000 shares.
