TRENCHING UNDERWAY - Gary Kilpatrick, president, reports the west portion of the grid has been completed on its Clubine Comstock project near Nelson, B.C., held under option from prospector Eric Denny. The company is waiting for geochemical and geophysical survey results. Trenching will be around the galena stringer zone and other anomalous areas.

The galena stringer assayed 39.3% lead, 5.5% zinc and 28.9 oz.silver/ton. A soil sample 15 meters down slope assayed 1,019 parts per million lead, 1,843 ppm zinc and 2.7 ppm silver 350 meters northeast of the stringer. Four soil samples covering 150 meters of ground, assayed on average 640 ppm lead and 3.1 ppm silver with one sample being 1,093 ppm lead and 5.4 ppm silver. About 150 meters southeast of the stringer, a soil sample assayed 1,026 ppm lead, 1,816 ppm zinc and 2.2 ppm silver. Trenching will also be done near the mineralized float which assayed 0.414 oz.gold/ton and around the No.1 level where samples returned 63.7% lead and 59.3 oz.silver/ton.
