SUN PROPERTY UPDATE - Michael Levinson, chairman,

reports Bradner Resources Ltd. received assay results from one of its seven veins on the Sun property near Cranbrook, B.C. The claims are situated three km southwest of the recent Barkhor discovery and 40 km south of the Sullivan mine at Kimberley. (SEE PROPERTY LOCATION MAP GCNL NO.121, P/3, June 22,1990) A grab sample returned 56.56% lead and 18.65 oz.silver/ton from the favourable Aldridge formation, an indicator of Sullivan-type mineralization.

Cominco, the previous operator on the Sun property, defined a strong lead/zinc geochemical soil anomaly 1,900 meters long and up to 500 meters wide which has yet to be drilled. Bradner has staked an additional 93 claims bringing the property holdings to 113 units covering 5,600 acres. A detailed geological and geophysical survey will begin immediately to be followed by diamond drilling. (SEE GCNL No.125, 28Jun90, P.1 FOR OTHER PROJECT INFORMATION)
