HARRISON EXPLORATION RESULTS - Richard J.H. Barclay,

Abo Resource Corp., reports operator/joint venture partner Bema Gold Corp. has completed a 6,900-foot diamond drill program on its Harrison gold project 90 km east of Vancouver, B.C. The project is owned 40% Abo and 60% Bema. Bema also owns 40.6% of Abo's outstanding shares. Previous diamond drilling had outlined an extensive hydrothermally altered breccia pipe containing gold, silver, zinc mineralization. Hole BX 90-144 intersected 17 meters averaging 1.1 grams gold/tonne (0.0038 oz.gold/t) and 2.5 grams silver/tonne. Hole BX 90-141 cut 32 meters grading 0.6 grams gold/tonne, 2.41 grams silver/tonne and 0.22% zinc.

The Hill Stock drilling was designed to test the Jenner style mineralization encountered in 1989. Hole HL 90-145 intersected 34 meters grading 1.0 grams gold/tonne. The management of Abo Resource Corp. are now assessing the results. (SEE GCNL No.32, 14Feb90, P.2 FOR PREVIOUS INFORMATION)
