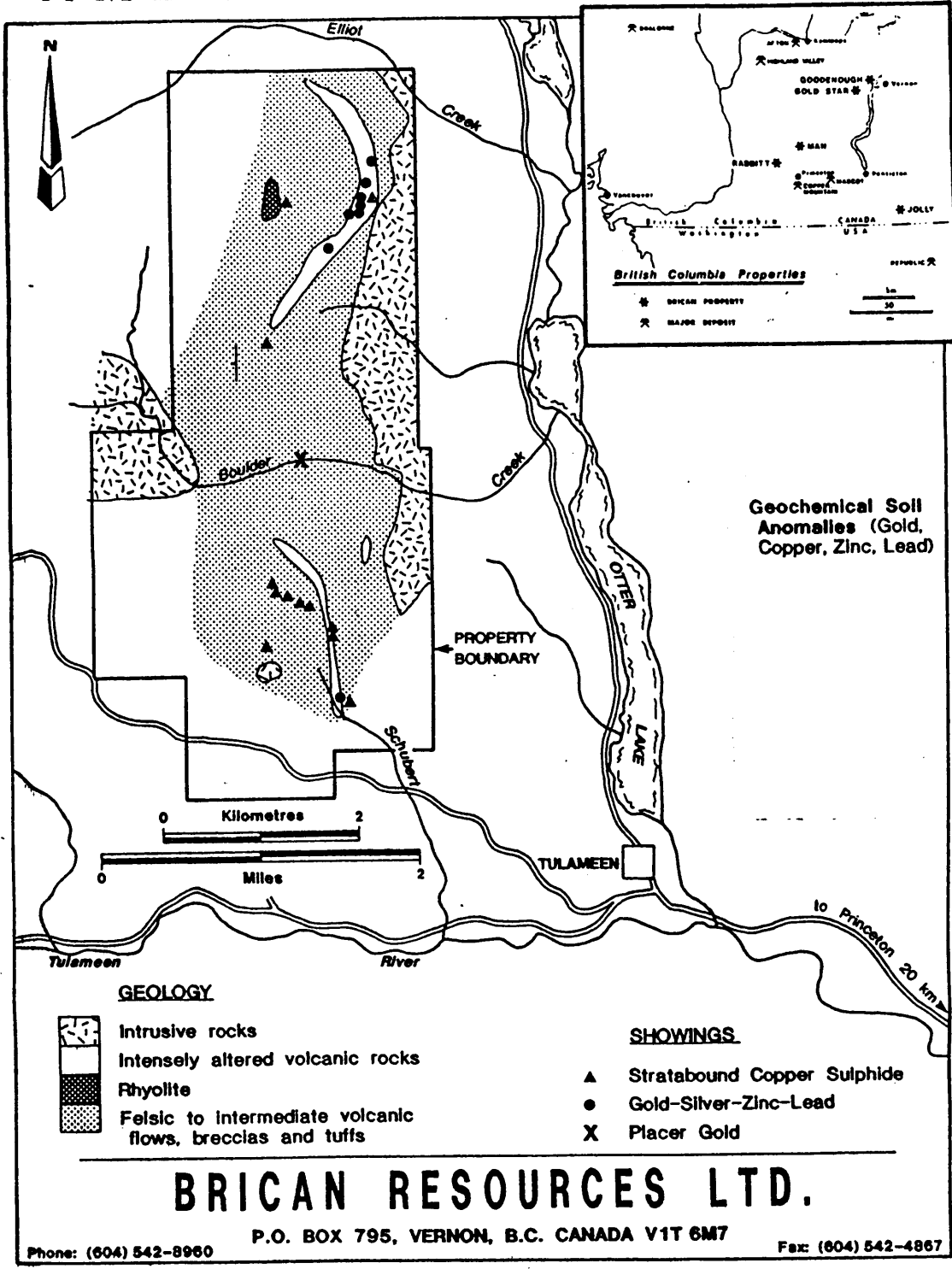
reports Brican Resources Ltd. plans a drill program to test known targets on its Rabbitt property near Tulameen, B.C. with funding to be provided by a joint venture partner. SEE MAP OVERLEAF PAGE 1 A major mining company is presently on the property considering a possible partnership. The 96-unit polymetallic property covers a strike length of 4.6 miles of felsic volcanic rocks belonging to the Nicola group. Brican's Man copper/gold porphyry property, 18 miles northeast of the Rabbitt property, is also hosted by Nicola group rocks.

To date, some \$600,000 has been spent on the Rabbitt property. Geological, geochemical and geophysical surveys have been completed over most of the property as well as some trenching to test anomalies. Surface sampling has yielded values up to 0.4 oz.gold/ton. In 1987, 12 short holes were drilled in the cousin Jack area where previous drilling indicated the presence of gold and silver values. The best holes returned 0.21 oz.gold/ton over 5.0 feet and 0.075 oz.gold/ton over 20 feet, including 5.0 feet grading 0.20 oz.gold/ton. There are numerous other showings of gold, silver, copper, zinc and lead. (SEE GCNL No.66, 3Apr90, P.2 FOR OTHER BRICAN INFORMATION)
