HIDDEN VALLEY WORK TO BEGIN - John Nebocat, director has reported Kookaburra

Gold Corp. plans to resume work 3Jul90 on the Hidden Valley property situated 25 miles west of Smithers,



Last season's mapping, sampling and prospecting program has shown epithermal style precious and base metal veins traversing the property along steep structures. The veins host arsenopyrite, galena, chalcopyrite, tetrahedrite and locally massive pyrite in a quartz-carbonate-barite gangue. Select samples run up to 0.38 oz./ton gold and 10 oz/ton silver.

The property was previously explored for porphyry type copper and molybdenum mineralization which occurs in an elongated intrusion at the center of the claims. Mid to Upper Jurassic volcanics surround the porphyry which occurs at the boundary between Bowser Basin sediments to the north and Hazelton Group volcanics to the south.
