JACK WILSON CREEK - H. Schellenberg, director, reports
PROJECT IN PROGRESS Bellex Mining Corp. and Quattro
Resources Ltd. have begun 1990

exploration program on the Jack Wilson Creek project
located in the Galore Creek camp about 150 miles
northwest of Stewart, B.C. Drill results are expected
in late July. Quattro may earn a 50% interest by
spending \$400,000 by 30Sep90 and additional \$350,000 by
31Dec90. The claims are subject to a 1 3/4% net smelter
return royalty.

Exploration to date has outlined a 1.5 by 0.5 km
copper/gold soil geochemical soil anomaly in the North
Fork area that remains open to the north, south and
east. Superimposed on this area are aeromagnetic and IP
anomalies. On the western extent of the geochemical
anomaly, a 30-meter trench within a mineralized volcanic
unit yielded a weighted average of 1-meter panel samples
of 1.16% copper and 0.02 oz.gold/ton. Exploration will
also be conducted on the Saddle Ridge zone which has
returned 5.8 oz.gold/ton. (SEE GCNL No.73, 12Apr90, P.2
