ECSTALL RIVER PROJECT - Access to the Ecstall River
property is from Douglas Channel
then 12 km up the Quaal River and along Ecstall River.

The property contains a pyritic quartz sericite schist with concentrations of copper/zinc in three showings: Packsack, Horsefly and Steelhead. The Packsack deposit was discovered by drilling an electromagnetic target coincident with massive sulphides on surface. Eleven holes along a 500-meter strike length cut lenses of massive sulphides, one to 8 meters thick, and to a depth of 100 meters. The Horsefly massive sulphide zone has been indicated by electromagnetic and magnetic anomalies but has not yet been drilled. The Steelhead showing has not yet been drilled.

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
