located 30 miles north of Stewart, B.C. CATEAR RESOURCES INC. (CAA-V) and KEYLOCK RESOURCES INC. can earn a 30% interest by collectively spending \$1,000,000 on exploration. Seven holes totalling 1,360 feet tested one of several gold-bearing alteration zones defined by surface exploration. Intervals with values higher than 0.04 oz.gold per ton are shown above.

Because large portions of the core were not sampled, the full extent of the gold-bearing intervals is not known, in particular the section above and below the 10-foot interval in hole 88-3. A \$250,000 second stage diamond drilling program is planned for 1990 to include re-logging and assaying of the 1988 drill core.

Rock geochemical sampling uncovered numerous anomalous areas on the property. Of 349 samples collected, gold values ranged from 5 parts per billion to 0.442 oz.gold/ton; silver values from nil to 14.95 oz/ton. (SEE GCNL No.51, 13Mar90, P.1 FOR OTHER DATA)

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
