Because large portions o fthe core were not sampled, the full extent of the gold-bearing intervals is not known, in particular the section above and below the 10-foot interval in hole 88-3. A \$250,000 second stage diamnd drilling program is planned for 1990 to include re-logging and assaying of the 1988 drill core.
