TAKLA RAINBOW OPTIONED - Pierre B. Lebel, president, reports Cathedral Gold Corp.

has optioned a 50% interest in its 100%-owned Takla Rainbow property located about 48 km west of Manson Creek, B.C. to EASTFIELD RESOURCES LTD. (ETF-V), subject to regulatory approval. Eastfield must pay \$150,000, issue 40,000 shares by 30Jun90, and spend \$2,450,000 on exploration by 31Dec94 with \$400,000 to be spent by year end.

The Takla Rainbow property is within the Quesnellia Terrane, a geological belt hosting large copper/gold deposits including Similco, Afton, QR, Mount Polley and Mt. Milligan. Previous work on the property has focussed on the gold potential alone; however, recent rock sampling in the intrusive complex adjacent to the gold deposit at Takla returned values up to 2.25% copper and 0.014 oz.gold/ton. The 1990 work program is designed to expand existing geological gold reserves and test for porphyry copper/gold potential. To date, 74 holes totalling 49,000 feet have been drilled on the property. Geological reserves in all categories are 321,000 tons grading 0.25 oz.gold/ton.

Eastfield has a 100% interest in the adjacent Nell property. (SEE GCNL No.95, 16May90, P.3 FOR MORE DATA)
