near Salmo, 25 miles east of Trail, B.C. Noranda Exploration Co. holds an option to acquire a 51% interest in the property by cash payments of \$70,000 and \$250,000 exploration by Dec. 31, 1991. Yellowjack acquired a 100% interest in the claims from K. Murray for \$30,000 plus 200,000 treasury shares issuable in installments and \$40,000 cash by Dec. 31, 1990. Eleven holes have been drilled to test a coincident, high induced polarization chargeability, magnetic and soil geochemical anomaly in rocks of the Rosland volcanic series.
