Claimstaker Resources Ltd. has completed its 1990 diamond drilling and geophysical programs on the Tide Lake property located about 50 road-km north of Stewart.

B.C. Claimstaker is earning a 50% interest from TENAJON RESOURCES CORP. (TJS-V). One drill hole was completed before winter in the North Pit zone, which intersected two gold-bearing veins as follows:

surface over a 240-foot length and averages 3.8 feet grading 0.598 oz. gold/ton and 0.20 oz.silver/ton.

A multi-frequency electromagnetic survey was also completed in two areas - over the Susan/Anna zone and over the Pit zone. In the area of the Pit zone, a significant zone of conductivity was identified which is estimated to lie some 150 to 250 feet below the surface. This large anomaly underlies the high grade gold values found in the trenching in this area. The company is planning a program to follow up the 1990 work.
