

ADRIAN RESOURCES LTD. (ADL-V)

ASSAY RESULTS - William Campbell, secretary, reports
Adrian Resources Ltd. has received
underground chip sample assay results from the 867
crosscut through the 21B deposit on the Tok claim gap
portion of the Ski project located about 50 miles
northwest of Stewart, B.C. The underground exploration
program, designed to evaluate the 21B deposit, is being
directed by the Eskay Creek Joint Venture partners,
PRIME RESOURCES GROUP INC. (PRU-V) and STIKINE
RESOURCES LTD. (SKZ-V), which have signed an option to
earn 50% in the Ski property.

The 867-crosscut is located 15 m south of the
initial Tok claim crosscut (the 865-Crosscut) which
returned 1.56 oz.gold/ton and 40.5 oz.silver/ton over a
10-metre width across the 21B Deposit.

In addition, Adrian has received assays from
diamond drilling on the main portion of the Ski
property. Hole AD90-23 drilled on Section 15+00N
returned numerous geochemically anomalous values between
2502.6 feet and 2565.0 feet, including an interval
grading 0.092 oz.gold/ton and 0.49 oz.silver/ton over
29.5 feet between 2505.9 and 2535.4 feet. Drill hole
AD90-23 terminated at a depth of 2616.5 feet returning
0.289 oz. gold/ton and 0.34 oz.silver/ton over the last
2.3 feet between 2614.2-2616.5. Hole AD90-24 drilled on
Section 16+00N returned numerous geochemically anomalous
values between 2630.0 feet and the end of the hole at
2699.5, including 0.059 oz.gold/ton with 0.97
oz.silver/ton over 6.6 feet between 2676.5 and 2683.1
feet, and 0.047 oz.gold/ton with 0.99 oz.silver/ton over
the last 6.6 feet of the hole between 2692.9 and 2699.5
feet. Drill hole AD90-25 on Section 14+150N was
terminated prior to reaching the 21 Zone hosting
stratigraphy due to technical difficulty and is
currently being re-drilled as hole AD90-25A. Drill hole
AD90-26 completed on Section 13+07N returned no
significant values. Complete assay results are not yet
available for drill holes AD90-21 and AD90-22 located on
Sections 20+00N and 150N respectively. Three drills
continue to evaluate the stratigraphic, geophysical and
geochemical targets on the Ski property. Additional
drilling is also planned within the Tok claim gap to
further delineate the mineralization of the Pumphouse
