PROGRAM COMPLETED - William Campbell, secretary, reports Consolidated Goldwest Resources Ltd. and Tymar Resources Inc. have completed the 1990 exploration program on the Teryl option project located four miles northwest of the SNIP project in the Iskut River area about 100 miles northwest of Stewart, B.C. Goldwest and Tymar are jointly earning a 50% interest from TERYL RESOURCES CORP. (TRC-V). Exploration in 1990 comprised linecutting, soil and rock geochemical surveys, prospecting, geophysical surveys, mapping and overburden drilling for a total cost of \$170,000.

Prospecting on the ROB 16 claim indentified several quartz veins and stringers hosting molybdenite and pyrite with minor chalcopyrite and arsenopyrite along an intrusive/sediment contact. Individual veins are as wide as 1.0 meter. Rock samples from this area returned anomalous molybdenum values with the best result being 13,000 parts per million. One narrow quartz vein returned 0.162 oz.gold/ton with another vein 100 east east assaying 0.036 oz.gold/ton from a grab sample. Soil sampling and geophysics were completed over the North Grid on the ROB 15 claim. Soil sampling on one line returned a 200-meter wide gold anomaly with values ranging as high as 230 parts per billion.

Overburden drilling was utilized on the ROB 15 claim to obtain soils at the overburden/bedrock interface as thick overburden was believed to be masking true precious and base metal values in soils. A total of 103 samples were collected with the best result being 30 ppb gold. (SEE GCNL No.205, OCT.23/90, P.2 FOR OTHER PROJECT INFORMATION)
