GOLDEN BAND RESOURCES INC. (GBN-V)

ISKUT J/V RESULTS - Robert A. Evans, secretary, reports Golden Band Resources has received results from the Iskut Joint Venture project located immediately north of the Prime/Cominco SNIP deposit some 66 miles NW of Stewart, B.C. The project is an equal joint venture between PRIME RESOURCES GROUP INC. (PRU-V), AMERICAN ORE LTD. (AOE-V) and Golden Band. Phase II drilling comprised 289 meters in four diamond drill holes spaced at 50-meter intervals to test for strike and dip extensions to the shallow dipping sulphide rich tuff breccia unit. The best intercept was in hole I-90-12 where 5.1 meters averaged 0.085 oz.gold/ton which included a 1.0-meter interval grading 0.212 oz.gold/ton. Prospecting in the SW portion of the property indicates widespread copper/gold mineralization is related to an alkaline intrusive sediment contact zone. Initial results returned values as high as 0.155 oz.gold/ton and 43,745 parts per million copper from narrow quartz veins. Soil sampling is defining numerous copper/gold values over a 550 by 700 meter area. (SEE GCNL No.148, 1Aug90, P.2 FOR PREVIOUS INFORMATION)
