JAZZMAN RESOURCES INC. (JZM-V)

1990 PROGRAM COMPLETED - Charles S. Underhill, president, reports Jazzman Resources has completed its 1990 drilling program on the GAB 9 project located 10 miles north of the Bronson airstrip in the Iskut River area NW B.C. The program was funded by CRIMSONSTAR RESOURCES LTD. (KRQ-V), which is earning a 50% interest by spending \$1,500,000 on exploration. This year, Crimsonstar spent \$500,000. The initial phase of drilling was directed toward locating the northward extension of Gulf International Minerals' Northwest zone. The first four holes were located 10 meters north of the Gulf-Jazzman claim boundary along strike with Gulf's northernmost drill intercepts. Concentrations of sulphide mineralization were encountered in all four holes. Assays up to 0.136 oz.gold/ton over 3.3 feet were cut within broad zones of highly anomalous gold values up to 65 feet thick. The strong alteration and mineralization persisted to more than 1,498 feet deep, where drilling was suspended due to equipment limitations. A larger rig was mobilized and hole 90-2 was extended to 2,219 feet and continued to intersect intermittent anomalous gold, including 3.3 feet grading 0.338 oz.gold/ton at 1,647 feet.

Future work will entail detailed structural mapping to establish a sense of movement on the Northwest zone trend prior to further drilling next year. (SEE GCNL No.186, 26Sep90, P.2 FOR PREVIOUS INFORMATION)
