CARDINAL MINERAL CORPORATION (CDB-V)

DRILLING PLANNED - Kevin Whelan, president, Cardinal Mineral Corp., reports field work is continuing in preparation for an anticipated 1990 drill program on the company's Gold 17-20 claims located 8 miles north-northeast of the Forrest Kerr airstrip some 70 miles northwest of Stewart, B.C. Joint venture partner BLUE GOLD RESOURCES LTD. (BLQ-V) can earn a 50% interest in the property by spending \$225,000 on exploration.

Initial prospecting has resulted in the discovery of a large zone of disseminated and massive sulfide mineralization within a silicified breccia. Widespread values as high as 1,340 parts per billion gold occur within a 650 by 1,600-foot zone on the southern flank of the Foremore Glacier. A similar zone of mineralization occurs on the north side of the icefield 3,600 feet to the north-northwest. Field crews are presently carrying out a program of detailed mapping along with additional extensive sampling in order to better define potential drill targets. The area of interest lies at about 2,500 feet above sea level and it is expected that work, which may include diamond drilling, will be carried out on the

property for at least another four to six weeks before winter shutdown. Progress is being made on the company's proposed restructuring.
