

HIGH FRONTIER RESOURCES LTD. (HFR-V)

On the 60Z-RDN property located about 30 miles north of the Prime/Stikine Eskay Creek discovery some 60 miles northwest of Stewart, B.C., 15 drill holes have been completed with three abandoned in overburden. High Frontier and joint venture partners NORANDA INC. and Kennecott Exploration are waiting for assays from holes RG-90-7, 11 and 15. Partial atomic absorption results from hole RG-90-7 indicate a zone of gold mineralization across 7.85 meters with fire assays due in a few days.

Drill hole RG-90-15 was drilled to undercut hole 7 zone and to check for a westerly dip. The hole cut numerous zones of mineralization with visual copper, zinc and lead. Assays are awaited. Hole RG-90-11 was drilled to test the Gossan Creek mineralization and a resistivity anomaly at depth. Surface grab samples in this area assayed up to 0.43 oz.gold/ton and a channel sample assayed 0.16 oz.gold/ton over 6.0 meters within a large gossan along the Downpour Creek drainage which is about 4,000 feet long and 1,000 feet wide. The holes intersected a blue-grey feldspar porphyry containing up

to 5% disseminated pyrite and five narrow areas of slight amounts of chalcopyrite and sphalerite mineralization from 9.5 to 51.5 meters. Assays are expected in a few days. Drilling has ceased due to winter conditions. (SEE GCNL No.180, 18Sep90, P.2 FOR PREVIOUS INFORMATION)
