CROESUS RESOURCES INC. (CWV-V)

ASSAYS RECEIVED - John MacAskill, director, reports Croesus Resources Inc. has received significant assay results from its two Iskut River properties northwest of Stewart, B.C. Croesus can earn a 100% interest in the CAM property 15 km east of the Bronson airstrip by spending \$300,000 over 3 years. Work entailed prospecting and reconnaissance mapping. Numerous showings of skarn and sulfide shear mineralization returned results worthy of follow-up. Skarn banding over 100 metres near the eastern part of the CAM 9 claim extends for several hundred meters in a northerly direction. Some of the better assay are below:

These are all prospecting grab samples from first pass prospecting. Follow-up work is continuing to define these occurrences in more detail before diamond drilling.

Croesus can earn a 100% interest in the IAN property 10 km east northeast of the Bronson airstrip and immediately north of the Hector/Nepheline property

by spending \$600,000 over 3 years. Work entailed limited prospecting and reconnaissance mapping. Several occurrences were discovered that were geochemically anomalous in gold, silver, arsenic, copper, lead, and zinc. Two samples of a quartz/sulfide showing assayed 7.71% and 2.53% copper.
