NEWICE DRILL RESULTS - William Campbell, secretary,
reports Tymar Resources Inc. has
received assays results from a drill program on the
Newice project located 68 miles northwest of Stewart,
B.C. Tymar and joint venture partner TICKER TAPE
RESOURCES INC. (TKT-V) jointly own a 100% interest in
the property. The 1990 drill program comprised four
holes totalling 960 feet targeted at the Mist showing,
which is a series of subhorizontal gold-bearing quartz
veins 5 to 15 cm wide. Grab samples of these veins
taken in 1989 ranged from 0.302 to 1.072 oz.gold/ton.
The veins are hosted in the same intrusive which hosts
the King vein, on which drilling in 1988 returned values
up to 1.04 oz.gold over 5.0 feet.

All four holes encountered granodiorite with numerous quartz veinlets up to 5 cm wide. Pyrite was the most visible mineralization, locally up to 5%; however, no significant assay results were returned from the holes. (SEE GCNL No.193, OCT.4/90, P.2 FOR OTHER PROJECT INFORMATION)
