NEW PROJECT ASSAYS - Naren Majitha, secretary, reports
Collins Resources Ltd. has received
assay results from a diamond drill program at the New project located 68 miles northwest of Stewart, B.C.
Collins can earn a 50% interest from ADRIAN RESOURCES LTD. (ADL-V) by paying \$5,000, issuing 200,000 shares and spending \$500,000 on exploration over three years. Collins is operator during the earn-in period.

The current program drilled known showings and completed a minor amount of prospecting. The 10-hole, 447.5-meter drilling program focused on a system of gold-bearing quartz veins known as the Paul and Number One showings in the northeast part of the property. The veins vary in size from 10 to 50 cm at the Number One to 0.5 to 2.0 meters at the Paul. Gold values in excess of 1.0 oz/ton are common from grab and chip sampling of the two showings with a best assay of 3.72 oz.gold/ton across 0.25 meters from the Number One showing. See table of assays above. Holes AC90-1 to 3 tested veins on the Paul showing; no significant results were returned from any of the veins encountered in the holes. Holes AC90-4 through 10 were drilled on the Number One showing and its strike length to the northeast. Elsewhere on the property, previous silt and soil geochemical sampling and prospecting has delineated five areas of interest to the south and east of the Paul showing area. These areas returned anomalous soil values of up to 605 parts per billion gold, 7.9 parts per million silver, 2,204 ppm copper, 1,110 ppm lead and 4,982 ppm zinc.
