During the July/90 field investigation, random traverses into areas not previously mapped, especially in the southern part of the claims, revealed numerous mineralized clusters of white quartz veins. Many veinlets and mineralized stringers were observed in greenstones and granodiorites in old exploration pits and trenches. The veins are up to several meters thick and, cross-cut the foliation in greenstones or are parallel to it.
