FIRST PHASE DRIFTING COMPLETED - Milan Gubash,

president, reports Toba

Gold Resources Ltd. has completed the first phase of drifting on the No.3 adit at its 100%-owned MAM property located near Usoyoos, B.C. The adit was driven for 26 meters along the mineralized vein which averages 90 cm in width. Channel samples taken at regular intervals along the vein gave the following results shown below:

grams gold/t and 2.70 grams silver/t) demonstrate mineralization is spreading from the vein at depth.

During the July/90 field investigation, random traverses into areas not previously mapped, especially in the southern part of the claims, revealed numerous mineralized clusters of white quartz veins. Many veinlets and mineralized stringers were observed in greenstones and granodiorites in old exploration pits and trenches. The veins are up to several meters thick and cross-cut the foliation in greenstones or are parallel to it.
