INTERNATIONAL SUNEVA RESOURCES LTD. (ISN-V)
MILA PROJECT UNDERWAY - Craig S. Angus, president,
reports International Suneva
Resources has completed work on the Mila project
near Vavenby, 80 km west of Kamloops, B.C.
International Suneva has earned a 50% interest from
GOLDBANK VENTURES LTD. (GCV-AS-110000) by issuing
50,000 shares and spending \$250,000 on exploration over
two years. The program will include geological mapping,
geochemical sampling and geophysical surveys. Budget
for this Phase II program is \$100,000.

Three mineralized zones have been outlined by

previous workers, including the east-west trending
Nicanex zone, the AFR zone and the Road showing. A
stream sediment survey was conducted in 1980. In 1984,
an east-west VLF-EM conductor was drilled with results
assaying 0.028 oz.gold/ton over 1.4 meters. In 1989, a
492 line-km airborne geophysical survey was flown that
outlined five strongly conductive zones. Other work in
1989 located two more prospects. The Dee showing
returned grab samples grading 2.8% lead, 6% zinc and
12.2 parts per million silver. The Jar prospect
returned grab samples with up to 0.2% copper, 1.1% lead,
0.890% zinc and 8.8 ppm silver. (SEE GCNL No.50,
