MASSIVE SULPHIDE DISCOVERY - Craig A. Angus, president,
reports International

Suneva Resources Ltd. has made a massive sulphide discovery on its Mila project located near Clearwater, B.C. The company can earn a 50% interest from GOLDBANK VENTURES LTD. (GBK.A-Alberta) by spending \$250,000 on exploration over two years.

The massive sulphide mineralization, discovered as a result of ground follow-up to an airborne geophysical survey, has been found in place and in sulphide float boulders measuring up to 3 by 5 feet in diameter. The mineralization appears to parallel a strong coincident magnetic-EM conductor with an overall strike length of 900 meters. Representative grab samples returned assays of: copper - 0.19 - 1.01%; zinc - 4.44 - 8.18%; silver - 2.3 - 25.7 grams/tonne and gold credits up to 0.33 grams/tonne. Intermediate to felsic schists in the area

of the sulphide showings have also consistently returned copper values from 0.1 to 1.53% with silver and gold credits. The 1990 exploration program has been extended to prepare the property for diamond drilling this fall.
