SIMILKAMEEN CLAIMS ACQUIRED - Larry R.W. Sostad,
president, reports

Kootenay King Resources Inc. has acquired two claims
comprised of 36 units located 30 km east of Hope, B.C.
for 100,000 shares. The Rail and Rail 1 claims are
situated five km northeast of the historic Treasure Mtn.
mineral showings discovered in 1894. The silver/lead/
zinc mineralization occurs in association with major
fault zones generally related to argillites of the
Pasayten Group of rocks and the volcanic breccias of the
Dewdney formation.

The Rail claims cover a northerly-trending fault
contact between Cretaceous intrusives and the Cretaceous
Winthrop facies of the Pasayten Group. Galena
mineralization with assays up to 20 oz.silver/ton has
