FURTHER TRACE ASSAYS - Willis H. Osborne, vice president, reports Westpine Metals Ltd. has received more assays from the drilling

program on the Taseko copper/gold property located 140 miles north of Vancouver, B.C. ASARCO can earn a 60% interest by spending \$3,650,000 on exploration and paying Westpine \$340,000 over four years. Holes W90-22 through 24 were drilled into the Lower North zone and Hole W90-25 was drilled to test the area to the southwest of the Lower North zone; holes W90-26 and 27 were drilled to test the 76 zone. See table above.

Westpine wishes to make a correction to its last report covered in GCNL No.163, 23Aug90, P.1. Hole W90-17 is on Line 12+00E, not 11+00E. Drilling continues.
