CHANNEL SAMPLING ASSAYS - Murray Pezim, chairman,
reports Eurus Resource Corp.
and 50/50 joint venture partner Thios Resources Inc.
have received assays from channel sampling on the Black
Dog zone discovery on the Rock & Roll project located
six miles northwest of the SNIP deposit in the Iskut
River area northwest of Stewart, B.C. The companies can
earn a 100% interest from Prime Capital Corp.

Hand trenching of the Black Dog zone has expose
massive pyrite, galena, sphalerite and chalcopryrite
mineralization in a sub-vertical shear zone over about
50 feet of strike length. The zone appears to be 8 - 10
feet wide and open along strike and to depth. The zone
appears to strike east-west. Thirty-one channel samples
were taken following initial gab samples. SEE TABLE

Trenching is continuing to expose the bedrock
beneath two gold-in-soil anomalies lying about 50 meters
on either side of the Black Dog zone, which may be the
in-strike extensions of the sulphide mineralization.
Soil geochemical sampling will be expanded around the
zone and VLF-EM surveys are planned to select sites for
drilling expected to start in Sept. (SEE GCNI. No.157,
5Aug90, P.2 FOR PREVIOUS RESULTS)

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
