PRELIMINARY RESERVE ESTIMATES - William Campbell,

Resources has reported a preliminary geological reserve estimate by Prime Explorations for the 21B deposit at Eskay Creek, located about 60 miles northwest of Stewart, B.C. A portion of the 21B deposit underlies the Adrian TOK claim gap which is part of the Ski project property.

' for dilution, minimum mining thickness, nor metal recoveries. Much of the reserve is considered probable, based on the average density of diamond drill penetrations at 25-meter centres. Calculations involved the cross-section method with gold and silver assay values not cut. Base metal values were not calculated into the reserve. The new reserve are higher than reserves calculated previously by Roscoe Postle and Associates Inc.

Potential for expanding the reserves within the Pumphouse Lake zone beneath the Adrian portion of the TOK claim gap is considered good. In-fill diamond drilling is recommended to test the mineralized horizons of the Pumphouse Lake zone on 25-meter drill centres.

The total geological reserve base on the TOK claim gap is an estimated 148,500 ounces of gold equivalent at the 0.10 oz/t gold threshold. This estimate does not include any mineralization on the northward extension of the 21B deposit on the remainder of the Ski project property, presently being drilled by Prime/Stikine.
