Also in the Iskut River area, Avondale is drilling two targets on the Forrest Kerr project located 65 miles northwest of Stewart. The primary target is the Goldpan showing. Sampling of the oxidized zone exposed by a trench earlier in the summer returned 11.72 oz.gold/ton. Additional sampling of 11 similar zones in the Goldpan showing gave seven assays ranging from 0.254 to 1.18 oz. gold/ton. The showing is coincident with an induced polarization chargeability anomaly, which itself is associated with a VLF-EM conductor with a minimum 650 foot strike length up to a maximum 1,500-foot length.

The second target is the strike extension of the Creek zone where previous drilling intersected 88.6 feet of 0.052 oz.gold/ton with 1.10% copper and 52.5 feet of 0.131 oz.gold/ton with 0.64% copper. Hole AVD-90-21, currently in progress 500 feet east of AVD-90-13, will test an area of strong gold-in-soil geochemical results which ranged from 1065 to 6250 parts per billion gold. The drilling here will also test the stratigraphy which hosts the Barry's Cliff showing immediately above the Creek showing which returned grab samples up to 0.330 oz.gold/ton. Avondale is in the second year of an option agreement to earn a 100% interest. (SEE GCNL No.154, 10Aug90, P.2 FOR PREVIOUS INFORMATION)
