GIM PROJECT RESULTS - Albert Gerry, president, reports Consolidated Kyle Resources Inc. has completed a soil survey on the GIM property located SW of the confluence of the Iskut River and Snippaker Creek about 10 km east of the Prime/Cominco SNIP deposit some 100 km northwest of Stewart, B.C. Kyle can earn a 100% interest by paying \$80,000, issuing 10,000 shares and spending \$1,000,000 on exploration by 26Jun92.

The Cave zone was discovered by DuPont in 1981. DuPont's grid was resampled in 1988 when three anomalously high gold soil concentrations were found ranging from 185 to 700 parts per billion near the southern margin of the zone. During the 1990 program, a two-meter thickness of mineralized volcanic was uncovered during trenching near the 1988 Cave zone sample sites. Subsequently, the whole area was extensively sampled. High gold in soil concentrations were found in more than a dozen locations that ranged up to 680 ppb. The AJ zone, located just south of the Cave zone, was discovered in 1990 by deflection of compass lines by a magnetic anomaly. Gold in soil concentrations assayed up to 6,270 ppb. The distribution of high gold in soil values between the Cave and A-J zones indicates they may represent a contiguous area of gold enrichment.

At the VG vein, located about 200 meters east of the GIM legal corner post, assays returned over 3.7 oz. gold/ton from a 1-4 cm thick quartz vein containing free gold, pyrite and iron oxides.

The company hopes to completed further work this season. More soil and rock assays are pending. (SEE GCNL No.102, 28May90, P.5 FOR OTHER INFORMATION)

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
